

2013 Student Right to Know Data Sheet

1) This data (cohort) is based upon the Fall Semester of 2013. It only includes first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who graduated within 150% of normal time. This totals 60 students (22 male and 38 female).

This summary was completed at the end of the appointed 6 years.

2) Of the above group of 60 students, 25 (8 male, 17 female) enrolled in a Two-Year program. Of the 25, 11 (3 male, 8 female) received an Associate of Arts degree and 1 (1 male, 0 female) received a Bachelor's degree within the 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 48.0%.

3) Of the above group of 60 students, 34 (13 male and 21 female) enrolled in a Four-Year Program. Of the 34, 0 (0 male, 0 female) received an Associate of Arts degree, and 13 (5 male, 8 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 38.2 %.

4) Of the above group of 60 students, 1 (1 male, 0 female) enrolled in the Five-Year Program. Of the , 1 (1 male, 0 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 100.0 %.

6) The combined graduation rate of these 60 students was 43.3% (26 of 60).

7) This information was obtained in accordance with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System's (IPEDS) Graduation Rate Survey (GRS).
