Executive Summary

On Assessment Day, April 7, 2020 we for the first time asked our graduating seniors to fill out the Program Goals Survey. This survey was given only to graduating seniors in each program. Assessment Day 2020 was held all online due to the COVID-19 pandemic that was sweeping our nation at that time. All classes had to be moved to an online format mid-March in light of the requirements to shut down the campus to slow the spread of the virus. The assessments given during this Assessment Day were therefore also all given in an online format. The Program Goals Survey was prepared as a Google Form and the students were given a link to that Form. The first question on the Form asked the student to choose their program from the options given. Whichever program they chose then took them to the section of the survey that pertained to their program. In their section of the survey the students would see the following statement: ***“Please give us your feedback about how confident you feel in being able to implement the goals for your program in your future vocation/ministry.”*** Following that heading each of the program goals would be listed as a separate question. Under each goal the following statement was included: ***“I feel confident in implementing this goal in my future vocation/ministry.”*** The student was given the following options as a response to the specific goal and statement:

- Disagree
- Strongly Disagree

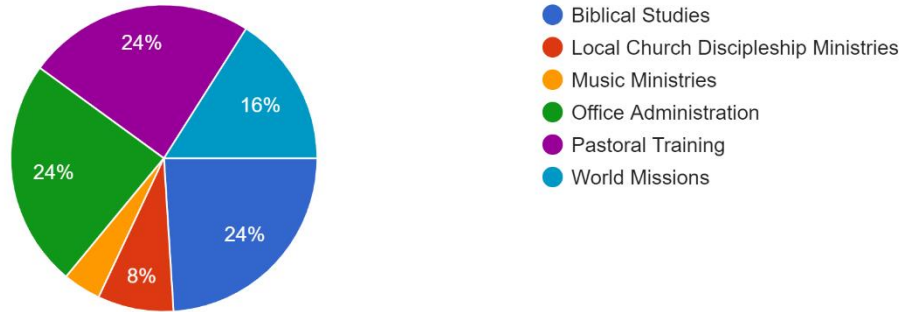

Executive Summary

The results of the survey are very good. Overall, 62% of the responses indicate that our graduating seniors agree strongly that they will be able to implement the various program goals in their future ministry/vocation. Only 38% of the responses indicated a slight decrease in certainty about being able to accomplish the goals that their program had set out for them. A mere 2% of the responses were neutral and no responses showed any kind of disagreement with feeling able to implement the stated program goals.

Since this is the first year to give this survey and collect this data it is not possible to make any comparisons or see any trends. It is noteworthy that the 2019/20 school year, during which this survey was given, was the beginning of the transition in the Office Administration program from Mrs. McFarling's leadership to that of Miss Cole. This is also the school year that would be Dr. Newman's last as a faculty member and chairman of the Local Church Discipleship Ministries (LCDM) program. Going forward the LCDM program will be under different leadership.

The plan for the future is to continue asking our graduating seniors for their input on how they feel about being able to implement the goals for their program once they get into their ministry or vocation. This survey will be given on Assessment Day each year.

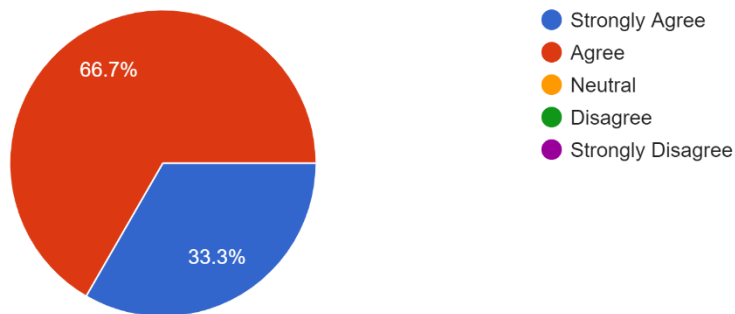

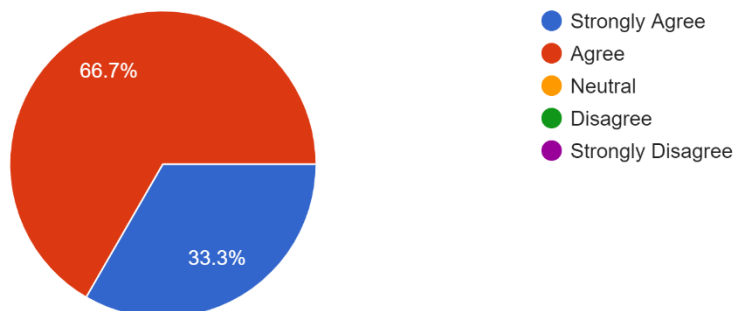

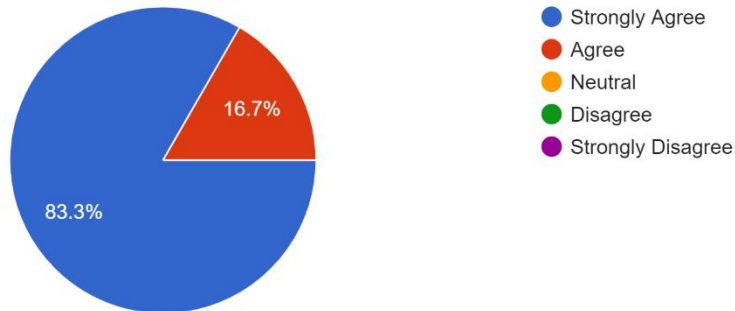

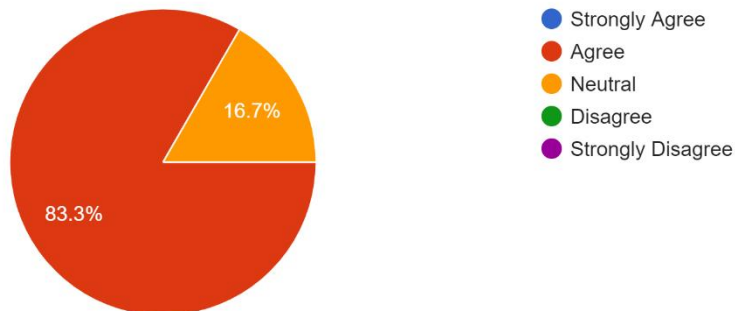

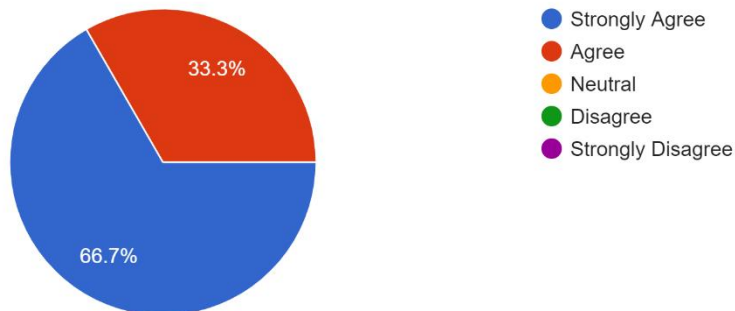

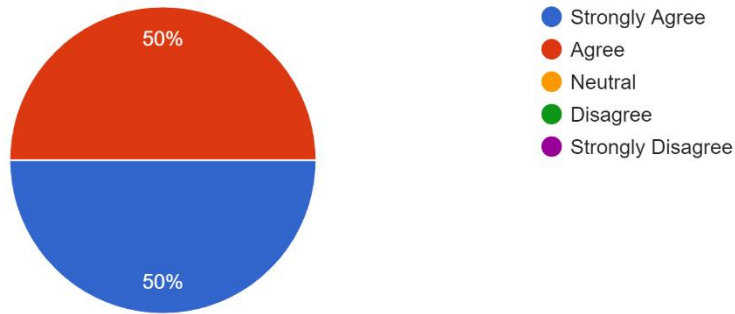

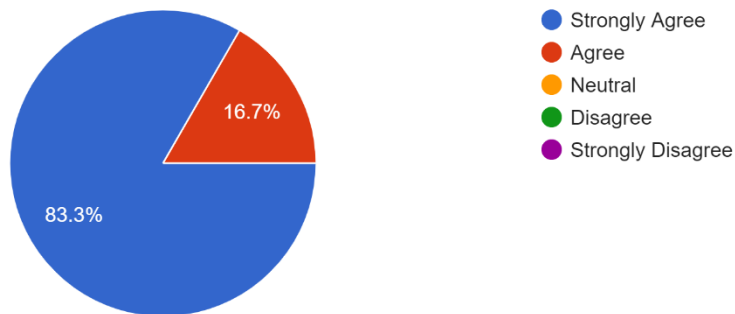

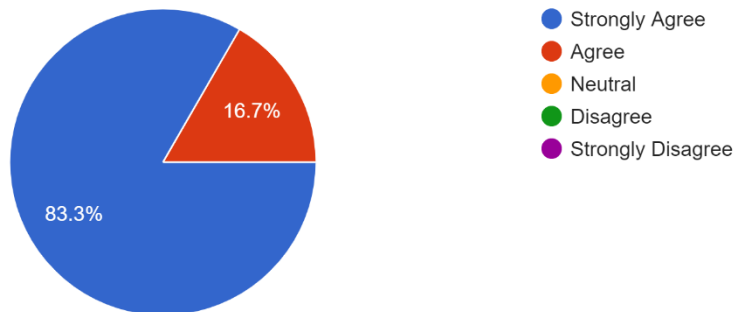

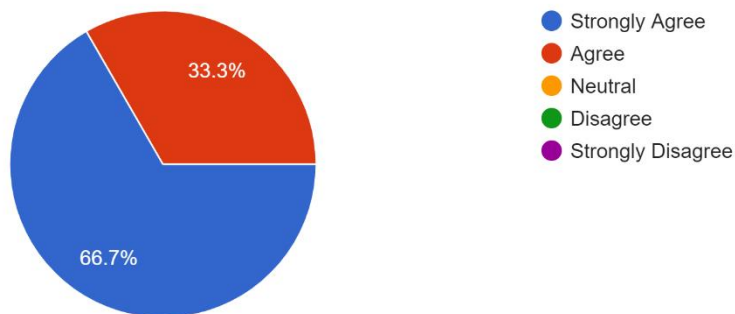

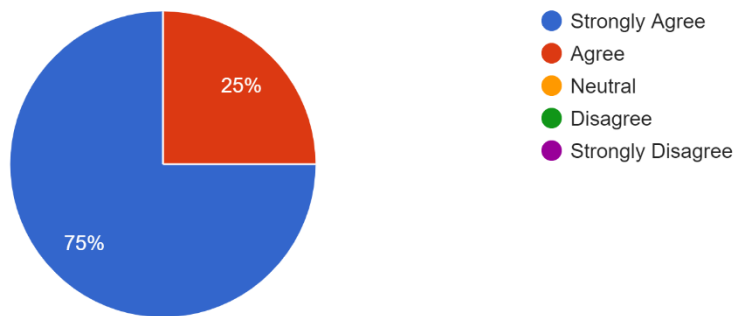
