

2014 Student Right to Know Data Sheet

1) This data (cohort) is based upon the Fall Semester of 2014. It only includes first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who graduated within 150% of normal time. This totals 87 students (40 male and 47 female).

This summary was completed at the end of the appointed 6 years.

2) Of the above group of 87 students, 27 (8 male, 19 female) enrolled in a Two-Year program. Of the 27, 12 (4 male, 8 female) received an Associate of Arts degree and 0 (0 male, 0 female) received a Bachelor's degree within the 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 44.4%.

3) Of the above group of 87 students, 60 (32 male and 28 female) enrolled in a Four-Year Program. Of the 60, 4 (0 male, 4 female) received an Associate of Arts degree, and 29 (15 male, 14 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 55.0 %.

4) Of the above group of 87 students, 0 (0 male, 0 female) enrolled in the Five-Year Program. Of the 0, 0 (0 male, 0 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 0.0 %.

6) The combined graduation rate of these 87 students was 51.7% (45 of 87).

7) This information was obtained in accordance with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System's (IPEDS) Graduation Rate Survey (GRS).
