

2015 Student Right to Know Data Sheet

1) This data (cohort) is based upon the Fall Semester of 2015. It only includes first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who graduated within 150% of normal time. This totals 75 students (31 male and 44 female). This summary was completed at the end of the appointed 6 years.

2) Of the above group of 75 students, 28 (11 male, 17 female) enrolled in a Two-Year program. Of the 28, 11 (3 male, 8 female) received an Associate of Arts degree and 3 (0 male, 3 female) received a Bachelor's degree within the 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 50.0%.

3) Of the above group of 75 students, 44 (20 male and 24 female) enrolled in a Four-Year Program. Of the 44, 3 (1 male, 2 female) received an Associate of Arts degree, and 23 (13 male, 10 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 59.1 %.

4) Of the above group of 75 students, 3 (0 male, 3 female) enrolled in the Five-Year Program. Of the 3, 0 (0 male, 2 female) received a Bachelor's degree within 150% of normal time with a graduation rate of 66.7 %.

6) The combined graduation rate of these 87 students was 56.0% (42 of 75).

7) This information was obtained in accordance with the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System's (IPEDS) Graduation Rate Survey (GRS).
