Licensure Disclosure

Faith Baptist Bible College prepares students for certification and licensure within the state of lowa. Students may want to attain certification within a different state according to their residence, and each state may vary in its licensure requirements. Below are the determinations Faith Baptist Bible College has found for each state in which our education program meets the educational requirements for professional licensure. Two options are indicated, meeting the certification requirements or not meeting the requirements. Faith Baptist Bible College is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission and the Association of Biblical Higher Education. The FBBC Education program is approved by the lowa Department of Education so that its graduates are eligible to receive the state's initial license. Graduates are also eligible for AACS and ACSI certification.

Pursuant to 34 C.F.R. § 600.9, Faith Baptist Bible College and Theological Seminary is required to disclose consumer information regarding our curricular programs that "foreseeably lead" to careers requiring state licensure. This regulation requires us to determine whether or not our licensure-related programs satisfy the educational requirements for professional licensure in the states where our prospective students are located.

Accordingly, we are required to disclose for each program that leads to licensure whether:

- 1. the program meets the educational requirements for professional licensure in a specific state;
- 2. the program does not meet the educational requirements for professional licensure in a specific state; or
- 3. we have not determined whether our program meets a particular state's educational requirements.

Because licensing requirements differ dramatically by occupational category as well as by state, we encourage prospective students to check their state legislative codes to verify the information presented here. This document is updated annually.

EDUCATION

FBBC's Teacher Education program meets the educational requirements for the following subjects in the State of Iowa:

 - 5–8 Middle School (Social Studies and English/Language Arts)

 - K-12 English as a Second Language

Most states on this list are part of the NASDTEC Interstate Agreement and offer full reciprocity of teaching licenses. In general, you are to complete the state's teaching license application and submit copies of official transcripts, your current teaching license, and documentation of any teaching experience you have. Agencies are NOT allowed to share FBI background check information, so new fingerprint copies must be submitted with the new application. Also check The Interstate Teacher Mobility Compact. Please know that the information listed above was what was available on the state licensing webpage at the time this document was reviewed. There may be additional requirements embedded in the application and/or its procedure. All state require background checks that will need to be completed.
